

## WHY CHOOSE SAFARI CLUB LTD?

- A Safari Club tailor made itinerary is infinitely flexible, you can add and subtract days add on different camps, parks or even countries your safari can be adapted to the budget and time available.
- Safari Club holidays use specially adapted 4x4 vehicles usually with a maximum of six people, not safari minibuses where the dynamics of the larger group can lead to a conflict of interest.
- 4x4 vehicles mean you have the ability to go off road, sometimes essential if game is not on the immediate roadside and for tracking game, breakdowns are less likely and you can cope with soft sand and mud.
- Full back up service is available for our vehicles so in the event of a vehicle breakdown, clients will be quickly rescued minimising inconvenience and freeing you to continue your safari
- Safari Club transfers between camps and parks on a tailor made holiday are almost always by air rather than by road, this means you spend more time in the reserves and less of your valuable holiday time is wasted travelling from place to place on slow bumpy roads.
- Many of the light aircraft and charter flights are extremely scenic and are an enjoyable part of your holiday.
- A Safari Club tailor made Safari does not travel on a fixed route which requires you to be at a certain place at a certain time, the lack of time constraints means you can, within reason, spend as long as you wish on any particular sighting or point of interest.
- Flexibility is an important aspect of a Safari Club trip, special interest groups can be accommodated sometimes with a specialist guide or exclusive vehicle use.
- Safari Club use road transfers where the overall trip is enhanced by road travel for instance on our luxury mobile safaris and some privately guided safaris.
- Our fully trained and experienced English speaking guides have a great affinity with the bush and are recruited where possible from local people. They are not from outside the area or occasional visitors without intimate local knowledge
- Our guides are based in the camps where you will be staying and have developed a very detailed knowledge of the wildlife that lives in the vicinity greatly enhancing game viewing.
- Our camps are located inside the National Parks and in private concession areas adjacent to the parks. In a private concession area you can enjoy activities frequently not permitted within park boundaries in particular, game walks, night drives and following game into the bush “offroad”
- Safari Club use small exclusive bush camps and lodges usually catering for a maximum of 30 guests to ensure our clients have an authentic bush experience. We do not use large chain game lodges which can be found in some parks and which can cater for up to 200 guests.

- Safari Club lodges and camps are as far as possible located in quieter areas of the National Parks and private concessions where visitor numbers are strictly controlled. This ensures that our clients do not experience the situation where you find six safari minibuses surrounding distressed wild animal as will be the case where visitor number are very high or uncontrolled.
- Wonderful gourmet meals are the norm at our camps usually eaten outside under a starlit African sky; we do not have bush canteens. In many places the Camp or Lodge owners host the evening meal with all guests and often the guides all dining together.
- Safari Club try to make their Safaris as inclusive as possible although drinks are extra at some camps, you will find that most eventualities are covered and the price quoted will be the total cost of your holiday.
- We do not usually quote for our trips inclusive of return International Airfares from Europe or USA as this allows the clients to buy their fares from their preferred airline at a competitive price on the Internet or even to use up those air miles. Assistance is given with locating the best flights and prices.
- Any holiday which includes a flight purchased from Safari Club Ltd is **ATOL** protected by the Civil Aviation Authority giving you full financial protection for any monies paid. **Our ATOL number is 9991.**
- Safari Club Ltd is a UK registered company operating within the Jurisdiction of British law. This is really important in the event of anything going wrong with your holiday. If you book with an operator based offshore or in Africa you will have very little chance of redress if you are unlucky enough to experience problems whilst overseas.
