

SERENGETI FLYING MIGRATION SAFARI



HIGHLIGHTS:

The Serengeti Flying Migration Safari visits the Lamai Wedge area of the Serengeti National Reserve in the extreme North adjacent to Kenya's Maasai Mara.

This remote area of the Serengeti receives very few visitors but can offer the same excellent year round game viewing as the Maasai Mara with outstanding wildlife action when the annual migration of wildebeest and zebra is in this area between June and October.

Access is by scheduled light aircraft flight from Arusha.

This superb safari is offered at a special introductory rate for 2011 and there is a large reduction for children.

Day 1

You will be met off your flight at Kilimanjaro Airport, met and assisted by our representative and transferred to Arusha for your flight to the Northern Serengeti.

On arrival you will be met off the flight and transferred to Serengeti Mara Camp for seven nights on a fully inclusive basis.

You will have time for an afternoon game drive.

This six tented luxury camp is located the Lamai Wedge area of the Serengeti bordering Kenya's Maasai Mara, there are only two camps in this remote wildlife rich region of the Serengeti and here you have the spectacular game viewing of the Maasai Mara without the crowds.

Activities here include game drives, guided walks and it is also possible to drive offroad. The Northern Serengeti is renowned for its sheer size, primeval landscapes and large populations of plains game that seasonally migrate to follow the nutritious pastures. It has become famous for the migration of 1.2 million wildebeest and the viewing of dramatic river crossings, which occur close to the camp. The sheer density of wildlife makes it also a predator haven with frequent sightings of lion, leopard and cheetah, predator interaction is common.

Resident game is prolific even when the migration is not present making the Lamai Wedge an all year round destination, offering a similar experience to the Maasai Mara. The stark beauty of the western escarpment and the open short grass plains provide a great backdrop to wildlife viewing.



Days 2 to 7

We will spend our days on morning and afternoon game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles looking for the abundant wildlife found in this region. Full day game drives with picnic lunches exploring deep into the Serengeti National Reserve are also possible. Unlike most areas of the park off road game driving is permitted allowing us to follow wildlife and tracks into the bush in search of great pictures and more elusive wildlife. We will also be able to take guided walks within the Serengeti National Reserve.

Day 8

After breakfast, you will check out and transfer to the local airstrip for your scheduled flight back to Arusha and onward connections a transfer is included for those clients flying home from Kilimanjaro International Airport.

Wildlife Sightings

Africa's wildlife is free ranging and moves according to seasonal availability of food and water therefore no sighting is guaranteed. The following species can be found in the areas visited on this safari and guests can expect to see many of them.

Elephant, Giraffe, Black Rhino, Lion, Leopard, Cheetah, Spotted Hyena, Jackal, African Wildcat, Serval, Caracal, Wild dog, Various baboon and primate species, Genet, Mongoose, Porcupine, Aardvark, Cape Buffalo, Zebra, Wildebeest, Impala, Grants Gazelle, Thompsons Gazelle, Eland, Duiker, Kongoni, Topi, Oribi, Dik Dik, Waterbuck, Lesser Kudu, Crocodile, Hippopotamus, Monitor Lizard, Ostrich, Bat Eared Fox, Honey Badger and mongoose.

When to go:

This Safari is a great option at any time of year but a particularly good choice during the migration period from June to October when the game viewing is sure to be spectacular with a good chance of witnessing crossings of the Mara River by the great herds.

Who should go?

This is a high quality safari that all will enjoy, with superb game viewing at any time. The safari will particularly appeal to those who would like Maasai Mara type game viewing without the crowds of visitors. The safari is at a highly discounted price which makes it very attractive
