

TANZANIA LUXURY MIGRATION SAFARI



This is fantastic and very high quality 4x4 guided adventure Safari through the classic East African Safari lands of Northern Tanzania.

This safari visits the National Parks of Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro Crater and the Serengeti National Reserve travelling overland with no backtracking or long transit days and returns to Arusha or on to Zanzibar by air.

The safari is designed to follow seasonal game movements in Northern Tanzania and the camps used are seasonal luxury tented camps located in the best possible areas for top quality game viewing. The exact itinerary is varied according to the season of travel.

Day 1

You will be met off your flight at Kilimanjaro Airport, met and assisted by our representative and transferred to the Arusha Hotel for one night.

Day 2

Today after breakfast, check out and drive to Lake Manyara National Park in your specially adapted 4x4 safari vehicle arriving in time for lunch. In the afternoon you will take your first game drive in the park. Your accommodation and location will be in Lemala Manyara Camp.

Day 3

Today spend full day in Lake Manyara National Park with twice daily game drives.

Manyara Camp

Lemala Manyara is a permanent camp located inside the Manyara National Park. Lemala Manyara offers an authentic safari experience in traditional style reminiscent of the golden safari era from a spectacular secluded location surrounded by fig and acacia trees with a backdrop of the towering Rift Valley Escarpment the backdrop for many Hollywood films set in East Africa. It lies approximately an hour inside the park near to the Endabash River with each tent having its own view of the lake. This is an area of the park which sees very little traffic throughout the day. Being based centrally inside the park, Lemala guests

can cover a wider game area and can start their 4x4 game drives as early as 6.15am to enjoy game viewing in relative peace. A variety of walks within the National Park are also available on request as well as night game drives. Guests are treated to bush breakfasts or lunches and sundowners in the evening by the camp fire.

Each spacious tent is fitted with large single or king-size beds with warm duvets, wooden flooring with rugs, 24-hour solar lighting, and en-suite bathrooms with a dressing area, flush toilet and a great safari shower.

Day 4

After breakfast, drive to the Ngorongoro Crater, the largest intact caldera in the world. Its enduring charm stems from its overwhelming beauty and the abundance of wildlife permanently resident on the crater floor. Your game drive will be on the crater floor with a picnic lunch. Tonight's accommodation will be at Lemala Ngorongoro Camp.

Ngorongoro Camp

Lemala Ngorongoro is an intimate, seasonal camp set in a delightful, ancient acacia forest on the rim of the crater next to the quiet Lemala access route. The camp offers accommodation under canvas in only 8 luxury tents and 1 family tent (accommodating 4 to 5 guests), which ensures seclusion in a pristine forest environment.

Each spacious tent is fitted with a gas heater, large single or king-size beds with warm duvets, wooden flooring with rugs, 24-hour solar lighting, en-suite bathrooms with a dressing area, flush toilet and a large safari shower.

In the evening, guests gather around the campfire for sundowners before dining under chandeliers, hosted by the camp manager. The camp works closely with the local Maasai community who often provide dances and talks on Maasai life, their culture, traditions and ceremonies.

Lemala's major advantage over any other accommodation in this area is the quick and easy access into the crater, which maximizes game viewing opportunities. The morning crater traffic is therefore avoided. Game drives from the camp may start as early as 6.15am and it only takes 15 minutes to descend onto the crater floor, the scenery is breath-taking and the wildlife abundant. Very often Lemala clients are on their own on the crater floor, enjoying the solitude and early morning light. Lemala guests therefore enjoy longer and significantly higher quality game drives.

The other advantage of this location is its close proximity to Ol Moti and Empakai craters, which offer beautiful landscapes and scenery. Walks from the camp into the forest and along the crater rim, together with an armed ranger and the Maasai, gives guests

spectacular panoramas of the crater and an insight into the forest dwelling animals.

Day 5

After breakfast, drive to the Serengeti National Park, undoubtedly the most famous wildlife sanctuary in the world, unequalled for its natural beauty and the greatest concentration of plains game anywhere.

Arrive for lunch at Lemala Ewanjan Camp in the game rich central Serengeti Region.

Afternoon game drive in the Reserve.

Day 6

Full day spent game driving in the Central Serengeti with picnic lunch.

Serengeti Camp

Lemala Ewanjan is a new deluxe seasonal camp with 7 beautiful tents set along the game-rich Seronera Valley in a spectacular location on the western slopes of Makoma Hill, in the Central Serengeti. The camp offers staggering views of the Serengeti migration, grasslands and sunsets. Major game viewing areas of central, southern or western Serengeti are easily accessible, and at the end of the day guests can return to the privacy and solitude of the camp to enjoy great service, food and ambience. The new high specification tents are some of the most spacious and comfortable seasonal tents in Tanzania. Each tent is fitted with 2 queen size or 1 king size leather beds, warm duvets, flush toilet, large safari shower, running water, wooden cabinets and flooring, 24-hour solar lighting, outside lounge and games table.

Lemala Ewanjan Seronera Valley is one of the best seasonal camps in Serengeti in a spectacular location. Because of the fantastic year-round game viewing in Central Serengeti, the camp is open all year except April and May during the long rains.

Day 7

Today after breakfast, check out and then we have a game drive transfer heading either South to Ndotu and the Short Grass Plains of the Southern Serengeti or North towards the Mara River depending on the season. We will arrive in time for lunch followed by an afternoon game drive. We will be staying at either Lemala Ndotu Camp or Lemala Mara Camp.

Day 8

Early morning game drive in the location of the migration followed by a late breakfast. We have the rest of the morning at Leisure then after lunch we take an afternoon game drive.

Ndotu Camp

Perched on the edge of a permanent marsh, Lemala Ndotu is the ultimate amphitheater for the wildebeest migration between December and April. 9 luxury tents of a very high specification are relocated from the Mara area of Northern Serengeti to this stunning Ndotu site between Dec and mid-April, to capture the drama that accompanies the migration. The

migrating herds of over 1.5 million wildebeest and zebra begin to arrive in December. Throughout February and March, the calving season takes place.

The camp is situated inside the Ngorongoro Conservation Area along the border of Southern Serengeti in one of the finest locations in the whole of Ndutu. Tucked away under huge umbrella thorn acacias, Lemala Ndutu offers fantastic views of the marsh which attract a large number of plains game and predators alike. The camp enjoys regular visits from the resident wildlife ranging from lions, leopards, cheetah and hyena to elephant and giraffe.

Another major advantage of the area is the ability to do off-road game viewing. Lemala's open 4x4 vehicles are specially designed with charging units and a large refrigerator so that guests can enjoy full day game drives with great picnic breakfasts and lunches organized by the kitchen as well as chilled refreshments. The camp also offers optional walks along the marsh with an armed ranger for closer encounters with the wildlife.

Appointed with large single or king-size beds with warm duvets, wooden flooring with rugs, 24-hr solar lighting, en-suite bathrooms with a dressing area, flush toilet and a great safari shower, all the tents are spacious and very comfortable.

Superb tents, personal hosting, al-fresco meals, fireside discussions, sundowners, spectacular views, breath-taking sunsets, prime migration viewing and optional walks are all a feature here.

Mara Camp

Lemala Mara is the ultimate seasonal camp in Serengeti, within touching distance of the Mara River and set under large *Euclea* trees in the heart of the best game viewing area of the Northern Serengeti. Here, in this immense remote wilderness, almost double the size of the Maasai Mara, guests can enjoy fabulous landscapes and terrific game viewing with practically no crowds. Resident wildlife numbers are exceptionally high, with prides of lion up to 30 strong, but nothing compared to when the migration starts arriving from June onwards. The area then turns into a wildlife paradise par excellence. Through June, July and August the wildebeest continue moving through the area, crossing and re-crossing the Mara River before heading north towards the Maasai Mara. Several large herds remain behind and weather changes could easily bring the vast herds flooding back into the area from the Mara. Migration and predator action lasts up to the end of October, assuring this area's reputation as one of the finest wildlife areas in Africa.

Two of the largest crossing points on the river are nearby and occasionally guests may observe the exciting crossings from the comfort of the camp. The spectacular Lamai triangle, Wogakuria kopjes and Kogatende airstrip are all very easily accessible.

Lemala Mara's naturalists/guides have exceptional local knowledge, enabling them to take guests to where the action is, in open 4x4 vehicles, away from the crowds. Lemala's vehicles are specifically designed for long game drives and come equipped with comfortable seats, charging units and a large refrigerator. The camp organizes great picnic breakfasts and lunches for those who want to go on full day game drives. The camp is open from 1 June to 31 October and has 9 luxury tents (accommodating 18 to 22 guests). The new high specification tents are some of the most spacious and comfortable seasonal tents in Tanzania. Each tent is fitted with 2 double beds or 1 king size leather bed, warm duvets, flush toilet, large safari shower, running water, wooden cabinets and flooring, 24-hour solar lighting, outside lounge, games table and much more.

Wildlife Sightings

Africa's wildlife is free ranging and moves according to seasonal availability of food and water therefore no sighting is guaranteed. The following species can be found in the areas visited on this safari and guests can expect to see many of them.

Elephant, Giraffe, Black Rhino, Lion, Leopard, Cheetah, Spotted Hyena, Jackal, African Wildcat, Serval, Caracal, Wild dog, Various baboon and primate species, Genet, Mongoose, Porcupine, Aardvark, Cape Buffalo, Zebra, Wildebeest, Impala, Grants Gazelle, Thompsons Gazelle, Eland, Duiker, Kongoni, Topi, Oribi, Dik Dik, Waterbuck, Lesser Kudu, Crocodile, Hippopotamus, Monitor Lizard, Ostrich, Bat Eared Fox, Honey Badger and mongoose.

When to go:

This Safari is available year round except for April and May. The itinerary is planned to take best advantage of game movements throughout the year and follows the path of the Great Migration ensuring spectacular year round game viewing.
